Please note that for no-ISHS members, the abstract submission will require a fee to be payed to ISHS by the presenting author. The cost for abstract submission is EUR 80 for individuals residing outside the European Union. For authors submitting from within the EU zone the abstract submission cost is EUR 95 (including VAT). For ISHS Individual members, the abstract submission charge is fully waived. Candidate participants non-ISHS members may decide to become members prior to registration and abstract submission and immediately benefit from the membership advantages (lower registation fee for ISHS members, abstract submission charge is waived for ISHS members, etc.). If a non-ISHS member pays the abstract submission fee, she/he will be entitled to pay the registration fee at the price indicated for ISHS members.
